

## Soccer Rules

1. The game will consist of two 7-minute halves. If the score is tied after regulation, a 5 minute overtime will be given. If the score is still tied, the game will be recorded as a tie.
2. If the score is tied after regulation for a playoff game, a two 5-minute halves will be played. If a winner is not determined, penalty kicks will be shot by 3 players. If it's tied, players who haven't participated in the penalties will be asked to shoot.
3. A match is played by two teams, each consisting of not more than 6 players, one of whom is the goalkeeper, and the match may not start if either team consists of fewer than 6 players.
4. Substitutes must report to the score's table and beckoned in by the officials.
5. Any of the other players may change places with the goalkeeper, provided that:
  - i. the referee is informed before the change is made.
  - ii. the change is made during a stoppage in the match.
6. If a substitute enters the field of play without the referee's permission:
  - i. play is stopped.
  - ii. the substitute is cautioned, shown the yellow card and required to leave the field of play.
7. A player must not use equipment or wear anything, which is dangerous to himself or another player (including any kind of jewelry). Players are required to have:
  - i. Cleats
  - ii. Jersey/shirt
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. The following behaviors will result in a yellow or red card and the possibility of a game suspension:
  - i. Cursing at the officials, supervisors, or opposing players
  - ii. Insulting the officials, supervisors, or opposing players
  - iii. Participating in a fight (AUTOMATIC EJECTION)
  - iv. Other unsportsmanlike acts will also earn a technical foul. All unsportsmanlike fouls result in two free throws and the ball, regardless of whether the foul is on a player or the bench.
